The **Future of Green Building Forum** at Earth Day Marin, **3:00 - 4:00 pm, Saturday, April 24**, Fusellman Hall, FH-120, College of Marin, 835 College Ave., Kentfield, will feature **Josiah Raison Cain**, a landscape architect, ecological systems pioneer and designer of the living roof on College of Marin's new Fine Arts Building currently under construction and **Bruce King**, a structural engineer and author of three books on alternative building materials founder of the Ecological Building Network in San Rafael, which hosted the international Build Well 2010 Symposium at Cavallo Point.

Andres Edwards, author of *Thriving Beyond Sustainability* and *The Sustainability Revolution* will moderate the discussion, which also includes **V-Anne Chernock**, Director of Modernization at the College of Marin and **Bernie Stephan**, Marin Realtor and radio host of *Post Carbon* on KWMR.

The five panelists will share their views of how we may be living 50 and 100 years from now, as well as steps we can take right now to address the needs of planet earth. Audience participation is encouraged.

Earth Day Marin, celebrating the 40th anniversary of Earth Day, runs from 11:00 am to 6:00 pm, with music, speakers, films, authors, fun performances for children, high-quality food and hands-on exhibits by key businesses and community organizations.
